RULES

- Entrants MUST be high school students.
- Entrants MUST participate in ONE Anti-Hate Action Center Hate Crime 101 training session: 3/21, 4/11, 4/22, 4/26, 5/9, 5/13, or 5/23.
- All art must be the entrant's original work. Plagiarism will result in disqualification.
- All mediums accepted: drawing, painting, collage, photography, sculpture, digital, etc.
- Entrants must also submit a one-paragraph explanation of what their artwork represents.

- Second Place: \$100 Visa Gift Card
- Third Place: \$75 Visa Gift Card
